The SafeWork NSW issued White Card does not expire and is recognised nationally. This WH&S induction unit must be achieved before access to any building and construction work site. It is recommended that persons not working in the industry do a refresher after 2 years of inactivity.

Prerequisites: You must bring **100 points of ID** on the day of the course, including a **Photo ID**. The WorkCover checklist is available at the College.

RIIWH202D Enter and work in confined spaces

This course is suitable for all persons working on, or intending to work on construction sites or other situations where there may be confined spaces. Learn to plan and prepare for entering and working in confined spaces, safely exit the confined space and clean up.

While there is no official expiry set on this qualification, it is recommended students recomplete the course if they haven't used it within the last 2 years. SafeWork NSW recommends this course be renewed every 3 years or based on internal policies and procedures.

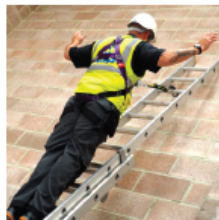

RIIWHS204D Work Safely at Heights

This course covers working safely at heights in the resources and infrastructure industries. It includes identifying the work requirements, work procedures and instructions for the task, accessing and installing equipment, performing work at heights and cleaning up the work area. This unit specifies the competency required to undertake safe work practices when working at heights or depths.



There is no official expiry date for this qualification however it is expected if students have not used their qualifications in 2 or more years they should recomplete the course. SafeWork NSW recommends this course be renewed every 3 years or based on internal policies and procedures.

Chemical Users Training

- **AHCCHM303 Prepare & Apply Chemicals**
- **AHCCHM304 Transport & Store Chemicals**

Legislation states that current training in chemical use is necessary to lawfully use pesticides in NSW in your work or business. This training meets the mandatory training and requirements of the NSW pesticide legislation. This course is aimed at all persons who use chemicals as part of their job / business including farmers, spraying contractors, nursery workers, grounds keepers and local government employees. Chemical User qualifications are valid for a period of 5 years after which the student will be required to complete the reaccreditation course before the current ticket expires.



Prerequisites for Refresher:

Participants must hold a current Chemical User qualification that has not yet expired and bring this to be sighted by the trainer on the day of the course. The Chemical User qualification, once refreshed, is valid for a period of 5 years.
