Minimum requirements for assessment - this is set by Roads and Maritime Services NSW under the RTO's licensing agreement as an Approved Training Provider:

"All students must meet these requirements to be deemed competent in the selected qualifications regardless of their status as a new entrant or existing worker:

1. Complete theory assessment for units applicable to the selected qualification
2. Obtain a third party verification report from an appropriate workplace supervisor
3. Complete a practical, on-the-job assessment
4. Additional fourth piece of evidence as deemed appropriate by the assessor"

Definitions

- New entrant - these are students who have little or no experience in the traffic control industry, or cannot provide any evidence of current experience. This will require students to complete a training component.
- Existing worker - these are the students who have and can prove current industry experience within traffic control. This will require students to complete a Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) application in order to provide the trainer with all the relevant information required to determine student competency.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be an additional cost for compulsory on-the-job assessment within 3 months of training which is subject to the number of people being assessed at any one worksite.

Provision of third party verification report and practical observation assessment must be completed within 3 months of receiving your RMS Statement of Completion (SOC) and endorsement for Traffic Controller and Implement Traffic Management Plan Modules of training.

Currently, if this is not completed within this timeframe, the SOC will lapse and training must be undertaken again. In some cases, the RTO can make the determination to provide you an additional 3 months to meet these requirements by issuing a further SOC and endorsement.

Assessment Procedure:

Traffic control COMBINED SKILL SETS

New Entrant training options:

1. 2 days training

Existing worker RPL options:

1. 1 day RPL session with trainer, prior questions to be completed
2. No classroom time - direct submission of individual RPL applications

Within 3 months of completing training component:

- Students will be required to have their supervisor complete a Third Party Verification Report.
- Students will be required to complete an on-the-job practical assessment.

On the job practical assessment can be completed through either of the following options:

1. Trainer on-site assessment
2. Video with audio submission

Either RIISS00044 - Work Zone Traffic Control - Traffic Controller Skill Set (Formerly "Blue Ticket") OR

RIISS00041 - Work Zone Traffic Control - Implement Traffic Control Guidance Plan Skill Set (Formerly "Yellow Ticket")

New Entrant training options:

1. 1.5 days training
2. 1 day training with prior questions to be completed

Existing worker RPL options:

1. Half day RPL session with trainer, prior questions to be completed
2. No classroom time - direct submission of individual RPL applications

Within 3 months of completing training component:

- Students will be required to have their supervisor complete a Third Party Verification Report
- Students will be required to complete an on-the-job practical assessment.

RIISS00045 - Work zone traffic control - Developer

New Entrant training options:

1. 2 days training

Existing worker RPL options:

1. 1 day RPL session with trainer, prior questions to be completed
2. No classroom time - direct submission of individual RPL applications

Within 3 months of completing training component:

- Students will be required to have their supervisor complete a Third Party Verification Report
- Students will be required to complete a final workplace assessment. This will be conducted through student submission of a minimum two (2) Traffic Management Plans (TMP's) they have developed.

Traffic Control

Traffic control COMBINED SKILL SETS (New Entrants - Theory Component only)

This course combines the following skill sets:

RIISS00044 - Work Zone Traffic Control - Traffic Controller Skill Set (Formerly "Blue Ticket")
and **RIISS00041** - WorkZone Traffic Control - Implement Traffic Control Guidance Plan Skill Set (Formerly "Yellow Ticket")

These skillsets when combined, cover the following units of competency:

- **RIICOM201D** Communicate in the workplace
- **RIIWHS201S** Work safely and follow WHS policies and procedures
- **RIIWHS205D** Control traffic with stop-slow bat

- **RIIWHS302D** Implement traffic management plan

This course, aimed at field staff and team leaders, provides training for personnel who are required to control traffic with a Stop/Slow bat and for personnel who are required to set up and work with Traffic Control Guidance Plans/Traffic Control Plans at a work site.
